

It's Showdown Time For North, Glenn Nines

It'll be showdown time at John Glenn Wednesday when North Farmington visits the Glenn baseball diamond.

As the saying goes, it'll be "a biggie" for both sides. Glenn leads the Northwest

Suburban League with a 6-1 record. North Farmington, which has won five straight since an earlier 3-0 loss at Glenn, stands second in the conference with a 5-2 mark.

Both teams won in brilliant

pitchers duels on Monday. Glenn blanked Thurston, 2-0, while North Farmington whitewashed Franklin 3-0.

GLENN'S DARYL Demaray posted his sixth victory overall and made it 4-0

in the league as he gave up two hits and fanned 13 in beating Thurston's Steve Kreager in a game which shaped up as a double no-hitter until the fifth inning.

Kreager also struck out 13

and allowed three hits. The first hit he yielded was in the sixth when Glenn put together his three singles — by Randy Horshok, Mike Borders and Dave Barrows — for its two runs.

Demaray lost his no-hitter

in the fifth inning when Don Murdock singled.

It marked the fourth straight game in which Thurston had been shutout.

JIM WHITE posted his fifth win against one loss as North

Farmington won from Franklin. He allowed three hits, fanned seven and walked one.

Loser Tony Kaseta walked four hits, struck out four and walked one.

North Farmington scored once in the first inning when Don Delling doubled in Doug Mohr, who was safe on an error.

IN THE LEAGUE's other games, Birmingham Groves scored four times in the first inning and held on to beat Oak Park, 4-3.

Jack Lamb singled to start the Groves' uprising. Russ Oliveto also singled and Harold Kuhn was safe on an error to load the bases.

John Dickson singled in two runs and Scott Freisner doubled in two more.

Dickson, the winning pitcher, allowed four hits. Rick Seid had two of the four Oak Park safeties.

Bishop Borgess Wins On Three Base Steal

The victory kept Borgess' hopes alive in the A-West Division. But the team still trails Dearborn Sacred Heart by two games.

Dan Gaudette, the losing pitcher, gave up seven hits. Borgess left 10 men stranded on the bases.
