

# Four Area Prep Golf Teams Gain State Finals

Four Observerland high school golf teams have won their ways into Monday's state championships in Port Huron. Three are Class A schools — Birmingham Groves, the 1970 runnerup, Plymouth and Farmington. The other is Farmington Our Lady of Sorrows, the state Class C-D champs two years ago.

Groves, which missed the state crown by a single stroke to Saginaw MacArthur a year ago, came in second at the 1970 regional with a 319 tally as Royal Oak Kimball won with 316 and Rochester won a playoff from Birmingham Seaholm for the third qualifying slot after both teams tied with 327.

AT GLEN OAK in Farmington, West Bloomfield's unbeaten team took the Class A crown with 305, with

Plymouth second with 308 and Farmington third with 316. Our Lady of Sorrows took second in the Class C-D regional at Romeo with 342, 13 strokes behind winning Goodrich. Dearborn Sacred Heart qualified with a 343.

Plymouth's Bill Johnson, shooting 33-37 — 70, shared medalist honors at Glen Oaks with West Bloomfield's Bill Bradford.

Bill Travers had a 74, Tim Quinn 80 and Jim Szilagyi 84 for the Rocks. Bill Houck with a 73 and Bob Chapman a 75 led Farmington into the state meet. Brad Cook scored a 79 and Rex Conroy an 89 for the Falcons.

Chris Strand topped Our Lady of Sorrows with an 81. Bill Robertson was next with an 85, topping Bob Grand with an 87 and Jim Bosenkotian 89.

In the Romeo regional, Lake Shore's Terry Cole took medalist honors with a 75.




