## PUT THE ARM ON POLLUTION...

That's the theme of our nationwide program to get older diesel engines to quit smoking.

Design improvements on newer Detroit Diesel engines have cut hydrocarbons by 80% and carbon monoxide by 40%, while reducing smoke by two-thirds, to a point where it's practically invisible.
