

# Local Reps Split 4-2 On Lottery

Four Observerland decided by the voters, but two The resolution squeaked representatives voted to have others voted against the the state lottery issued resolution. through the House, getting the bare 74 votes necessary to put in on the ballot. Voting for passage were Reps. Richard Young (D-Deerborn Heights), Marvin Stempien (Livonia), Thomas Brown (D-Westland), and Raymond Baker (R-Farmington).

Reps. John Bennett (D-Redford, Township), and James Tierney (D-Garden City), were among the 29 representatives who opposed putting the lottery on the ballot. Rep. Joseph Foyes (D-Oak Park) did not vote.

WHEN THE Senate passed a similar resolution the week before, all four of Observerland's senators had voted for passage.

The Senate and House resolutions are in conflict. The Senate asks to have the issue put to the voters in November 1972, and the House wants "speedier action in a special election on Nov. 2 of this year."

A measure to dilute the resolution, and limit lotteries to the state and non-profit charities failed by two votes in a 44-38 vote.

Reps. Young and Tierney voted for the amendment while Bennett, Stempien, Brown and Baker voted against it.

CURRENTLY the Michigan Constitution forbids lotteries and if the measure is passed by the voters, the State Legislature would have the authority to introduce a state statute allowing lotteries.

Supporters of the lottery cited the amount of revenue it could bring into the state—a possible \$100 million per year—since the state is in financial difficulties. By the end of the fiscal year the state will have a deficit estimated at \$36 to \$50 million.

But indications are that Gov. Milliken will not give the final OK on a lottery plan. The governor expressed his dissatisfaction with the lottery proposal last week.
