HBO programmers committed to 'Asylum'

There is no deeper darkness than that within the diseased mind. Enter the realm of the dangerously twisted when HBO takes you inside an institution for the criminally insane. *Asylum*, debuting Tuesday, March 10, is a graphic look at the treatment of Americans whose mental illnesses led them to commit often violent crimes, and who may someday return to society.

Hell hath no fury like a Viking spirit scorned. In the course of the Emmy-winning *Lost in the Barrens*, young Jamie (Nicholas Shields) and his Cree friend Awasis (Evan Adams) discovered an ancient Viking tomb. In the sequel, *Lost in the Barrens II: The Curse of the Viking Grave*, the two return to the wilderness along with an unscrupulous treasure-seeker (Cedric

Smith) and Awasis' sister Angeline (Michelle St. John) where they encounter Koonar, guardian spirit of the tomb. The three teenagers face threats from man, nature and the supernatural when the film premieres Friday, March 13, on The Disney Channel.

What are neighbors for? When Rose Finkler (Annie Mearns) is held hostage

in her Brooklyn apartment by the inept street punk Clash (Lou Diamond Phillips), she doesn't panic. Instead she makes him soup and sits him down for a long heart-to-heart. A presentation of General Motors Playwrights Theater, *Avenue Z: Afternoon* makes its entrance on A&E Tuesday, March 10.
