Daniel Seigert served as best man. The couple received guests at Arnie's Mobile Home Park Clubhouse. They are making their home in Livonia.

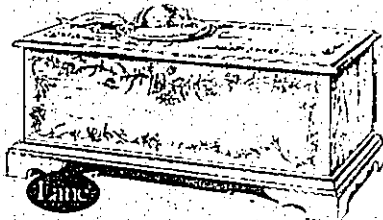
