Former Eccentric editor to receive Media Award

Jeanne Whittaker, former lifestyle editor at the Birmingham Eccentric, will be honored with the Media Award at the ninth annual Awards Celebration of Goodwill Industries of Detroit on Tuesday at the Ritz-Carlton, Dearborn.

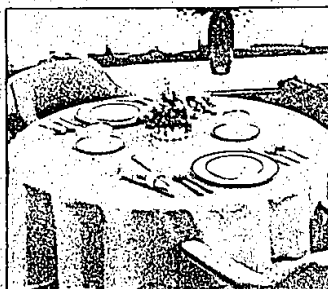

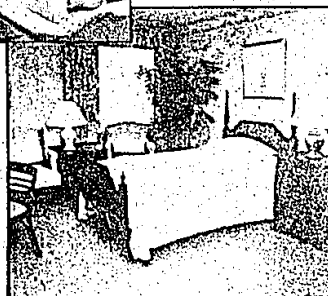
