County park sets spring nature programs

Oakland County Parks and Recreation is offering a series of spring nature programs at the Independence Oaks Nature Center on Sashabaw Road, north of I-75, near Jackson.

They include:

- Spring Star Party, 8-10:30 p.m., Saturday, May 9. The event involves a visit to Starline, the nature center's inflatable planetarium. Participants should bring a flashlight. Admission is \$2 per person.

Migration Meander, 8-10 a.m., Saturday, May 16. The event offers the opportunity to study warblers, waxwings, woodpeckers and other Michigan birds. Participants should bring binoculars.

This registration is required for all events. A park entry fee of \$1.50 per automobile for county residents, \$8 per automobile for non-residents, is required for events beginning before 4 p.m.

Programs are open to people with disabilities, though parks officials ask those participants to call well in advance so that their needs can be met.
