

OU 'Nightingale Awards' include 2 Troy nurses

The Oakland University School of Nursing announced the recipients of the Fourth Annual Nightingale Awards for Nursing, sponsored by the school's Board of Visitors.

The winners are Catherine M. Baldy, RN, BSN, MS, OCN, of Troy; Patricia A. DeMetsenare, RN, of Canton; Mary J. Denyes, RN, Ph.D. of Ann Arbor; and Denise Spencer, RN, of Sterling Heights who works in Troy.

Each will receive \$1,000 and a special bronze statue of Florence Nightingale at the Fourth Annual Nightingale Awards Dinner 7 p.m., Tuesday, May 12.

A record 450 members of the medical and nursing communities and the general public are expected at the dinner, which will be in OU's

Shotwell-Gustafson Pavilion. Tickets are available at \$35, and may be ordered by calling the OU School of Nursing at 313/370-4091.

Here are details on the winners:

- Catherine M. Baldy, clinical nurse specialist in hematology at Henry Ford Hospital in Detroit, will receive the Nursing Practice Award. She has cared for and counseled the critically ill at Henry Ford Hospital for more than 20 years and was named Oncology Nurse of the Year in 1981.

- Patricia A. DeMetsenare, assistant director of nursing at Westland Convalescent Center, will receive the Nursing Administration Award. A strong advocate of family involvement in the health care which she coordinates for residents,

she has encouraged several of her licensed practical nurses to pursue RN degrees.

dean and associate professor at the Wayne State University College of Nursing, will receive the Nursing Research Award. Recognized for

contributions to nursing theory development and advocacy of practice-oriented research, Dr. Denyes developed a significant study on the effectiveness of nursing actions to prevent pain in young people.

- Denise Spencer, who has spent 22 years in nursing education at William Beaumont Hospital, Troy, will receive the Nursing Education Award. She provides seminars, in-services and patient educational materials, and designed an outpatient diabetes program which drew this praise from an attendee: "In my 79 years, I have never found more patience and kindness than in this lady."

The winners were chosen from more than 100 nominations of nurses throughout the Detroit Metropolitan area. The awards dinner will be held on the birthday of Florence Nightingale, founder of modern nursing, who was born on May 12, 1820 in Florence, Italy.

Dinner speaker will be Mark Nichols, vice president of Ralph Nichols Corporation. Mr. Nichols understands first hand the benefits of outstanding nurse care as a kidney transplant recipient. Mark is a 1981 graduate of OU where he majored in biology.

The OU School of Nursing has nearly 1,000 students in a wide variety of programs, including a master's of science degree.

The Board of Visitors is made up of 20 volunteers from the health care field and others interested in nursing.
