CBS, ABC announce new Saturday lineups

Network executives play with Saturday-morning lineups like children with their toys, or so it seems. But as in prime time, there are only so many good ideas to go around, so while Fox is gaining ground with kids, NBC has decided to pack it in as of this summer. That leaves CBS and ABC to tinker in their animated toyboxes, and each of the networks has recently announced plans for fall '92.

CBS runs *Riders in the Sky*, *Inspector Gadget* and *Muppet Babies* (which moves to Fox) out of town, and leaves fans wondering Where's Waldo?, too.

The replacements, though spun from box-office hits, teeter on the verge of the pensive. *Fievel's American Tails* and Disney's *Little Mermaid* and *Raw Toonage* are all based on characters kids may have outgrown. In the plus column: *The Amazing Live Sea Monkeys*, a Howie Mandel brainchild, sounds like a visual treat.

ABC's first-year casualties were *Hammerman* and *Pirates of Dark Water*. Saying *Beetlejuice* three times won't bring that show back, either. Replacements are *Wild West C.O.W. boys of Moo Mesa* and *Goof Troop*, one a wacky Western cartoon and the other a patrol with Mickey's, 60-year-old sidekick, Goofy. (What is that in dog years, anyway?) *The Addams Family* (with John Astin), however, might break the freshman jinx and outlast the season.
