

Township man assaulted by 2 men in his garage

A 43-year-old Bloomfield Township man was attacked in his garage early Saturday morning by two men, one of whom was armed with a handgun.

The victim told police he went out to water his flowers at his house on Squirrel Drive at about 11:30 p.m. He said he saw two vehicles pass by the house twice. When he

was finished watering at about 12:30 a.m. he went into his garage, according to Bloomfield Township police Lt. Jeffrey Werner.

While in the garage he was ap-

proached by the two men. One man produced the gun and demanded money.

The victim said he didn't have any money. One of the men then

asked if the house had an alarm system. The man said it did. His hands were then tied behind his back and he was placed the floor.

The two men then ran out with-

out taking anything, Werner said. The man was able to free himself and call police.

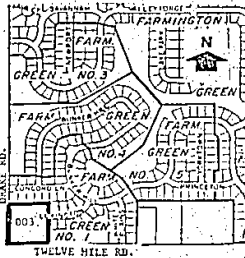

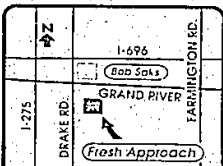

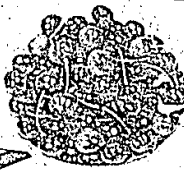
