


Good time for bowlers to go shopping

The summer season means better deals on a new ball, lower rates to go out and practice on the lanes, and an opportunity to try something new and different. If you have been thinking about getting a new ball, there are a lot of new models on the market.

The pro shop expert is there to give you the best advice on what is best for you. In those situations where the shop is located inside a bowling establishment, an attendant can watch how you deliver the ball and make an evaluation of it.

The ball itself just becomes more scientific than ever, not just what is the correct weight for you, but what kind of weight block is in the ball. There are variations in balance that

can be done by drilling the holes differently. This can help you get a ball that will hit harder and carry better.

Today, most of the new balls are made with a urethane outer shell, which has done more to help bowlers knock down pins than any other development. There are still some rubber balls on the market, and quite a few polyester products as well.

These cost less, but are not as effective with today's lane conditions.

On the Ladies Pro Bowlers Tour last week, Tish Johnson tried 18 different balls until she found the right one, the "Beast" from Columbia 300.

With this ball, she came out and dominated the field for a decisive victory. Many other top competitors today in the new Purple-Hare "Nito" by Ebonite, while Brunswick has introduced a new "Hinno Pro," which is still under evaluation.

The best way to find out which ball is just right for you is to visit the pro shop. Each one in our area

is excellent, and they will use their knowledge and experience to put you in the best suited equipment for your ability.
