

WHEN IS IT ALL RIGHT TO HURT?

1. Aching means something is amiss. However, there are aches which represent a recurring discomfort but not a condition leading to eventual crippling or impairment.

2. Aching means that the pain is of tension. You may be a person who handles stress in a stiffness of your muscles and joints; you have periods of aching which come and suddenly leave. There are days you awaken well, and days you lie all night. The aching settles in your shoulders and back as your mood reminds you that a great (emotional) weight rests upon you. You find that a hot shower helps, and the working out, if possible, or the distraction of recreation, eases the pain. If you watch carefully, you may find the connection between the aching and the time you last ate.

3. Aching is the hurting that occurs after usual effort. When you have more problem recognizing the connection than you would believe. As you age, your resiliency leaves before your sense of self acknowledges the loss of recuperative power. What you need as you grow older is more time to repair not a medical evaluation to uncover a secret of nature residing in your joints.

If aching is accompanied by a swollen joint, or you lose use of your hands, fingers or knees, the above does not apply. Then you seek a doctor's evaluation without delay.

The following preamble and resolution were offered by Member Members Campbell and Taylor:

WHEREAS, this City Council does hereby determine that it is necessary to acquire and construct street improvements ("Improvements") in the City described in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

WHEREAS, the cost of the Improvements is estimated to be Four Hundred Sixty Eight Thousand Dollars (\$468,000.00), and

WHEREAS, to pay for part of the Improvements the City Council deems it necessary to issue Bonds in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) and issue Bonds as authorized by the provisions of Act 171, Public Act of Michigan, 1952, as amended ("Act 171") and WHEREAS, the Bonds issued under the authority of the City Council are to be used for the purpose specified in Section 6 of Act 171.

WHEREAS, the Bonds issued under the authority of the City Council are more than sufficient to comply with all the requirements specified in Section 6 of Act 171.

WHEREAS, the Bonds issued under the authority of the City Council are hereby approved and adopted.

2. The period of maturity of the Improvements is estimated to be not less than severally years.

3. The City Council determines to borrow the sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) for the payment of the principal of the Bonds issued under the authority of the City Council.

4. The Bonds shall be designated 1992 MICHIGAN TRANSPORTATION FUND BONDS and shall consist of bonds having a principal amount of \$1,000.00 each and matures on January 1, 2002, and the principal amount of \$300,000.00 not exceeding for each maturity the maximum principal amount of the Bonds of that maturity and numbered consecutively in order of registration. The Bonds will be dated as of May 1, 1992 or one other date as may be determined by the Transfer Agent.
