

GOP elects area convention delegates

A mix of old and new faces will sit in Michigan's 72-seat delegation at the Republican National Convention Aug. 27 in Houston.

Gov. John Engler has attended before, but this time he will head a delegation 100 percent for President George Bush.

All three candidates for national committeewoman — winner Betsy DeVos of Ada, the outgoing Ronna Romney of Bloomfield Hills and challenger Andrea Fischer of Birmingham — were placed on the at-large delegate slate.

Laura Reyes Kopack, attorney from Livonia and member of the state Civil Rights Commission, and party patron Max Fisher of Franklin, and Detroit councilman Keith Butler, the only known Republican elected in Detroit, also will attend.

Here are delegates and alternates from area congressional districts:

9th District

State Sen. Mat Dunaskas of Lake Orion was elected a delegate along with state representative candidate Yvonne Strother of Rochester Hills and Ray Kelly of Flint.

"I was an alternate in '84," Strother said, "and a helper to the delegation in '88. I'm excited."

Her resume is a long list of party posts: State Committee member (and vice chair of finance), past president of the Oakland County Lincoln Day Club, Republican Women's Business and Profession-

al Forum and the Rochester Republican Club.

"We've been a family that's always been in the political arena," said Strother, who started with yard signs in the '70s and graduated to party offices when the children got out of high school.

Alternates are Richard Roy of Waterford, Diane Dunaskas (wife of the senator) and Carrie Garfield.

12th District

Delegates are Robert Goselin, Madeline Vick and Robert Anderson.

Alternates are Cathy Longo, Paulina Krajcub and Yvette Charles.

11th District

"After 26 years, I decided it was my turn," said Audrey Greenleaf,

whose husband, Harry, has been a district chair, a delegate in 1976 and an alternate in '88.

She long has been active in GOP women's groups and is Livonia co-chair of Joe Knollenberg's congressional campaign.

She was picked — along with Patrick Anderson of Farmington Hills and Judy Biedinger of Bloomfield Hills — at the new district's Friday night caucus, but the grandmother of two confessed it didn't really hit her until "they sang 'The Star-

Spangled Banner' this morning. This is an important position."

Harry is chair of the old 2nd District, Biedinger of the old 18th District, and everyone acquiesced in the deal they cut: two delegates from the old 18th and one from the old 2nd.

Alternates are state Rep. Jan Dolan of Farmington Hills, Marion Dalton of Bloomfield Township and Southfield councilmember Denise Alexander.

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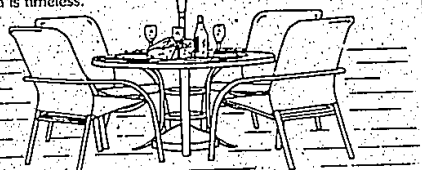
