I used a 155mm telephoto lens to keep my distance yet still fill the frame. My shutter speed was fast enough to stop any sudden motion and the aperture was large enough to blur out what could have been a distracting background.

If indoors, try natural light from a window. You may need a faster film but window light is beautiful and you'll capture a special mood in your shot.
