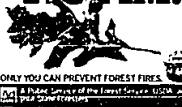

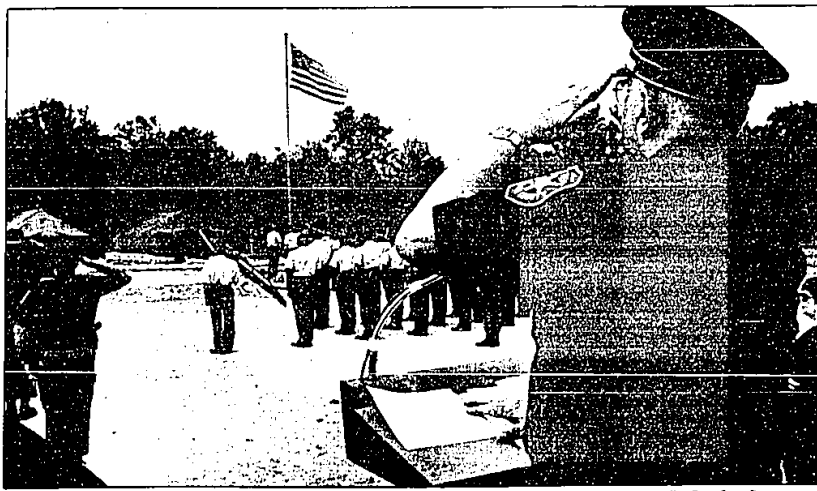

Register today for primary

Unregistered voters interested in voting in the Aug. 4 primary must register by Monday, July 6.

Registration is continuing at all Secretary of State branch offices as well as at city, county and township clerk's offices.

Those currently age 17 are eligible to vote if they will turn 18 before the Aug. 4 primary date.

Currently, there are nearly 5.8 million registered voters in Michigan, roughly 85 percent of the eligible voting population.
