She is the daughter of Pam Howard of Detroit and he is the son of Robert and Suzann Allison of Farmington Hills.

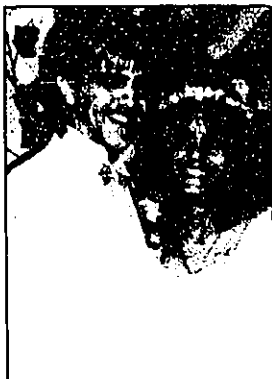
The bride is a graduate of Pearson High School and is employed by Machus Red Fox.
