## Nature-Botany-Art Courses Set At U-M Botanical Gardens

ANN ARBOR Registrations are now being taken for several outdoor nature-botany and art courses to be held at the Matthaei Botanical Gardens of the University of Michigan. The nondegree courses are open to all men and women in the southeastern Michigan area as part of the summer program of the University Center for Adult Education. The UCAE is sponsored by the University of Michigan and Wayne State University. These courses will be offered at the Botanical Gardens, 1800 Dixboro Road:

"Michigan Flora: Summer Wildflowers and Woody Plants," beginning June 10; "Drawing and Painting from Nature," beginning June 15; "Pollution in our Water," beginning June 15; and "Horticultural Botany I: Ornamental Plants," beginning July 12.

PROF. WARREN H. Wagner, director of the Botanical Gardens and botany professor at the U-M, will teach students to identify flowers and woody plants and to know how they relate to the environment, in lecture and field trip sessions, in the summer wildflowers offering. Miss Beth Urdang will teach the drawing and painting from nature course, relating to natural forms and landscape. A similar course was very popular the past term.

Teachers, conservationists, and others interested in learning about the minute organisms so important to our water resources will have an opportunity to study algae and the polluted environment in the course taught by Prof. Gordon E. McBride, assistant professor of botany at the U-M.

Adults will learn how to recognize and identify many popular varieties of cultivated plants, and to study their form

and structure in the Ornamental Plants offering taught by Edward L. McWilliams, assistant professor of botany, U-M. Plants studied will include woody ornamentals, indoor tropical plants, and the annual and perennial favorites.

Interested persons may register at the U-M Extension Service, 412 Maynard Street, U-M Campus, Monday through Friday, 9 to 12 noon, and 1 to 4:30 p.m. Mail registrations also will be accepted at this or any UCAE office.

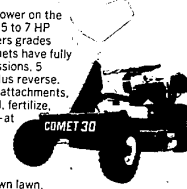

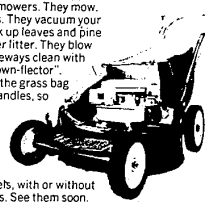
