



Remodeling Hinges On Bond Revision

Revision of a \$1-million bond issue to allow school remodeling will be an issue facing Clarenceville voters in the June 14 election.

Changing needs of the district brought on by decreasing enrollments prompted the board of education to seek the revision of the original \$3-million bond issue passed in 1965.

Schools Advised: Hold Line

An Oakland County task force has come up with recommendations to put before the local board of education that would make a 3.14 per cent increase the bargaining maximum in salary increases.

Task Force 28 was made up of one delegate from each board of education in Oakland County. Area representatives included Dr. Samuel Prisk, Clarenceville School District trustee; Aldo Vagnozzi, trustee from Farmington; and Dr. John W. English, Southfield superintendent who advised the group.

Summer Swims Set At C'ville

Clarenceville High School's pool will be open this summer with registration for student swimming set from 9 to 11 a.m. on June 21-25. Registration will be in the high school office.

Swimming sessions are scheduled to start Monday, June 28; Monday, July 12; and Monday, July 26. Each session consists of 10, one-hour lessons (week days for two weeks).

Students must be 48 inches in height or be able to pass the Red Cross beginners test. Class time will be determined at the time of registration. Instruction will be offered from 1 to 5 p.m. in beginner, advanced beginner, intermediate and advanced swimming.

All instructors are adults certified by the Red Cross. Class fee is \$7. A fourth session will be added if there is sufficient demand. It would start Monday, Aug. 9.

THE SUMMER adult swim class is scheduled to start Monday, June 14. Registration is from 7 to 8 p.m. the same day. Fee for 10 lessons is \$7.

Classes are offered in beginning and advanced swimming.

Adults also are reminded of the hour of recreational swim time reserved year around for them on Wednesdays from 8 to 9 p.m.

Other information may be obtained by calling William Waters, pool director at the high school.

The summer recreational swimming schedule is as follows: Wednesday from 7 to 8 p.m., open to all; 8 to 9 p.m., reserved for adults. Saturday from 7 to 8 p.m. and from 8 to 9 p.m., open to all. Sunday from 2 to 3 p.m. and 3 to 4 p.m., open to all.

Height requirement is 48 inches (42 inches at the shoulder) unless accompanied by an adult or responsible swimmer. Cost is 25 cents for students and 50 cents for adults. The above schedule includes time for showering and dressing.

The pool will be closed July 3 and 4 for Independence Day and Sept. 4 for Labor Day weekend.
