This bold blend of "film noir" and western influences finds a trio of cold-blooded killers forced to hit the road after slaughtering a whole family of witnesses in L.A. A pair of case-hardened police detectives track them to Arkansas, where the local sheriff has his own ideas of justice.

"Manhattan" (USA — 1980). Stunning black-and-white cinematography and music by George Gershwin add to Woody Allen's masterful look at life and love in New York City. "Monster in a Box" (USA — 1992), through Sept. 30 (call for show times). In this film version of one of his stage monologues, Spalding Gray relates the laborious process of creating his autobiographical novel, the "monster" of the title. In the same vein as his earlier "Swimming to Cambodia," this time directed by Nick Broomfield.
