It's fall and the furnace flim-flam rtists may be knocking at your

artists may be knocking at your toor.

When you answer that ad in the paper, or telephone offer for a fall furnace "check up," you may be inviting a furnace sales person into your home.

The unscrupulous, fast-buck furnace operator typically comes into the home under the guise of giving your furnace a check-up, but soon announces, "You need a new furnace."

"They will point to normal discolorations, such as 'blossome' on the
heat exchanger, and say your furnace has gone had," said Tom
Leckie, vice president of
Bergatrom's inc., in Livonia.
Some rust on the heat exchanger
is normal and does not affect its operation or safety, but the film-flam
covered will say you need a new

Another ruse is to use a very technical-looking electronic box with lights that flash. Guess what?

They flash red, indicating your furnace is not operating efficiently and you'll need expensive parts or a new furnace.

They may even say the furnace might blow up or is putting out toxife furnes that could kill you.

Unfortunately, the elderly or unkniwelegable homeowner are easy prey for the furnace fast-buck artist and may be sold a furnace for \$3,500 to \$4,000, that could be installed by a reputable dealer for \$3,500 to \$4,000, that could be installed by a reputable dealer for \$3,500 to \$2,000.

"Just say, hold it. I'm getting a second opinion," said Leckie, whose company recommends second opinions when expensive repairs or replacement is needed.

That second opinion should be your own gas company or a long-standing reputable lead elselec.

In doing 300 to 500 fall furnace time-ups a year in the western Detroit suburbs, Bergstrom's technicans find only 10-15 cases where a new furnace is actually needed.

Always go for the tune-up or "clean and adjust," nather than a "check," asid Leckie. The latter is often offered in big ads or phone calls for as low as \$19,95, so low that you might suspect its only a doo-opener for a sales pitch.

A tune-up costs only \$35 to \$50 from companies like Bergstrom's. It means you get 30 to 45 minutes of from companies like Bergstrom's. 
