Water main issue has some steamed

Sandy Secrest stood before the Farmington Hills City Council Monday and held up a birthday card her husband received. On it, two dogs are at a birthday party talking. In the background, another dog is flushing a toilet. The quote under the picture reads: Bad news, Fred just flushed the punchbowl.

"This is tragic, but this is what our friends think," she said. Secrest and her husband, who jointly own property on Bldestone Lane, say the end of their year-long battle to be connected to city's water main is finally in sight. On Monday the city council approved a controversial \$44,500 outlay for the installation of a watermain to four lots in the northwestern corner of the subdivision. Each lot owner will also pay \$11,000 for the connection. The council approved the move 6-1, with Mayor Jonathan Grant dissenting. Although Secrest said she sympathized with neighbors who did not want the connection, she was happy with the decision. "You shouldn't have to fight with your neighbors for something as basic as water," she said.
