## Police hunt for clues in baffling shooting

Police continue to question friends, associates and family members in an attempt to trace the steps of 22-year-old Vertia Christopher Dickson took before his death by shooting Sunday in Southfield.

Dickson's body was discovered around 8:45 p.m. in the upstairs apartment he shared with a friend in the Twyckingham Apartment complex on 12 Mile, west of Lahser. Police spokesman L.A. Moore said his spartment mate told him he found the body when he returned from work.

The Oakland County medical examiner's office said Dickson died from "gunshot wounds to the cheat and abdomen." An autopay was conducted Monday.

At present, police have no suspects in the slaying. "We're working on the belief that he was killed by someone he knew and that robbery ment the motive," Moore said. "There was no sign of forced entry into the apartment and we've found no indication of anything was taken that womething was taken that womet

Dickson's body was found in his bed covered by a quilt. Police refused to reveal how the victim was dressed and the caliber and type of gun used in order to protect the investigation.

"What we're focusing on right now is retracing the vic-tim's steps before he was killed — where he may have been and who he was with and who saw him. We don't even know if he left the apartment."

The crime was reported to police at 8:57 p.m. The victim was pronounced dead at the scene by Southfield paramedics.

Dickson's death is the sec-ond murder reported in South-field this year.


