'Name Your Adventure' this Saturday morning

"You have to remember, with anything you want to do, have fun with it," actor/tap great Gregory Hines advises two fawning fans in an episode of NBC's Saturday-morning show *Name Your Adventure*.

Taking that fun factor and running with it (and dancing with it, riding horseback with it and who knows what else), *Name Your Adventure* is an alternative to cartoons for children who feel like soaking up some serious vicarious entertainment in the world's most awe-inspiring locales. The camera tags along as the show's hosts, Mario Lopez and former MTV veejay Jordan Brady, leap-frog from one guest's fantasy adventure to the next, alternately offering informative tidbits and cracking wise.

The possibilities are endless for a program with such an ambitious format, but don't expect a young guest to scale the World Trade Center with

suction cups any time soon. Early visitors to *Name Your Adventure* seem to fantasize more about visiting recycling plants and learning a few dance steps than wing-walking or sword-swallowing.

But as a credit to the cast and crew of *Name Your Adventure*, even the least adventurous excursions are no less entertaining. The show manages to move at warp speed while delivering plenty of humor and hands-on instruction.
