white slightly more than 8,000 voted for Briggs.
But whoever the people voted for, the turnout was high.
"This is the biggest I've seen in the nearly 12 years I've been here," said Finneren. At one point voters watted up to 90 minutes to be a support of the beauty School, the turnout was also high, said election worker Madeline Westbate.

Knollenberg kept voters waiting more than two and a half hours after the polls closed before making an appearance. And he was

Briggs said he was not surprised with the heavy voter turnout.

"It's been a hectic night," said Briggs as he and supporters clustered around TV sets at the Clens of Bloomfield Apartments in Bloomfield Township.
"I'm excited for president Clinton. His support in Oakland County did help us." Briggs said.

Both candidates had campaigned hard, knocking on thousands of doors, sending out literature and meeting with voters.

Briggs was generally seen as the underdog in the heavily Republican area that was dominated by Broomfield for more than three decades. He challenged Broomfield two years ago, and was soundly defeated.

But with the restructuring of the district to include more borcrate voting areas in Southfield and Livonia, Briggs felt he had a good chance of winning this year.

Despite the changes, the dis-

trict held sound to its conserva-tive Republican roots, and Knol-lenberg offered the continuation of the Broomfield tradition, which voters welcomed.

Briggs, of Birmingham, is the great grandson of Walter O Briggs, who owned Briggs Stadi-um, which became Tiger Stadi-um. Knollenberg was a longtime supporter and adviser of Broom-field.
