Crash into median wall kills Lake Odessa man

A 59-year-old Lake Odessa, Mich., man died following an accident Thursday morning on 1-696 about 200 feet east of the Middlebelt overpass in Formington Hills.

Donald Orro Haney died from injuries after the cement-form truck he was driving crashed into a median retaining wall at about 6:05 a.m., State Police Trooper Merk Tinney of the Northville post said.

Witnesses told police a Ford Ranger pickup, driven by Timothy Glenn Foss, 23, of South Lyon, tried to avoid rear-ending the truck driven by Haney, lost control and swerved around in front of the truck, striking the truck and sending both vehicles into the median wall while traveling east on 1-696. The impact sent Haney and two passengers flying out of

the passenger door of the truck, on to the shoulder of the westbound left lane.

Hancy was taken to Botsford Hospital in Farmington Hills where he died a short time later. One of Honey's passengers, Jose Zamora, 56, of Detroit, was taken to Providence Hospital in Southfield where he was admitted. The other passenger, Virgillo Vasquez, 29, also of Detroit, was taken to Providence, treated and released. Foss escaped with no injuries.

The truck suffered heavy damage, the pickup suffered some damage.

Traffic was reduced to one lane each way until about 9 a.m., Tinney said. The accident remains under investigation.
