defensive tactics instructor at the Wayne County police academy and an officer in Livenia. Officers should "constantly strive to improve and review techniques. If they don't, eventually they're going to less them."


Proudlock said officers in his department are not allowed to carry impact weapons, although they carry a container with a form of tear gas.

"I've always felt that cadets should train with empty hands so they don't have to use impact

weapons," he said. "If I can't beat you empty-handed, then you go free. That's not the philosophy of the department or the training department. That's just me."
Richard Tillman, director of the Oakland Police Academy, says police training schools should teach cadets and officers to be "good human beings as officers" and that "excessive use of force" is not a cuphemism for "police brutality."
