Heston twixt heaven and Hell's Kitchen

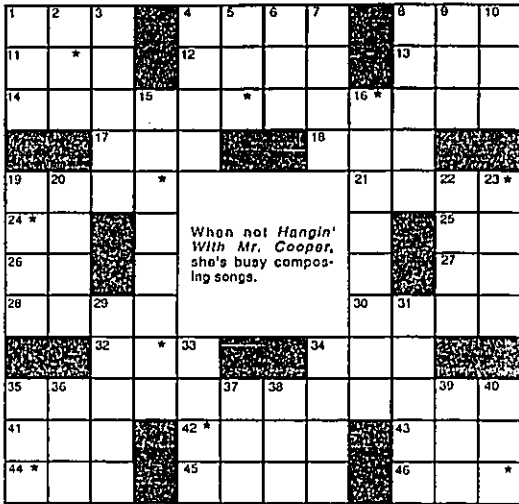

Charlton Heston knows the value of good material. The star of the biblical epics *The Ten Commandments*, *Ben-Hur* and *The Greatest Story Ever Told* now lends his powerful voice to the four-part performance documentary *Charlton Heston Presents the Bible*, starting Sunday, Dec. 20, on A&E.

The actor worked his way up from a humble beginning. Born Charles Carter, the Michigan native studied on an acting scholarship at Northwestern University before enlisting for a stint in the Air Corps. Back in civilian life, Heston and his wife, Lydia, moved to New York's Hell's Kitchen, where he worked sporadically as an artists' model before getting his first break in community theater.

After his 1948 Broadway debut in *Antony and Cleopatra*, Heston found work in the new medium of live television, in programs such as *Studio One*. He crossed the bridge to Hollywood in 1950 with the film noir *Dark City*. Since then he has made his mark as the lead in many historical dramas, but his roles in fictional films are equally memorable: *Ruby Gentry*, *Treasure Island*, *Planet of the Apes*, *Will Penny* and *Soylent Green* are but a few.

Politically outspoken, Heston has served six terms as president of the Screen Actor's Guild and chairman of the American Film Institute, but is not interested in public office.

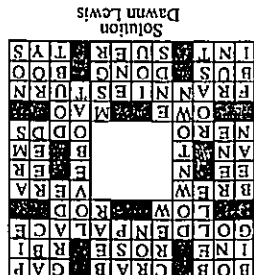
