He crossed the bridge to Hollywood in 1950 with the film noir Dark City. Since then he has made his mark as the lead in many historical dramas, but his roles in fictional films are equally memorable; Ruby Gentry, Treasure Island, Planet of the Apes, Will Penny and Sayland Generals has found and Soylent Green are but a few.

Politically outspoken, Heston has served six terms as president of the Screen Actor's Guild and chairman of the American Film Institute, but is not interested in public office.


