

Hills man dies in crash in Novi

James Domin, 21, of Farmington Hills died Dec. 15 after he was struck by a motorist while loading a car onto a tow truck on 12 Mile Road in Novi.

According to Novi police reports, Domin was hit shortly after 11:30 p.m. and was dead on arrival at Botsford Hospital. He was struck from behind while standing on the edge of the westbound lane behind the car he had just

hooked up from a previous accident, according to police. He was employed by Leford Collision.

The driver, Dawn Bauer, 18, of Highland Township told police she did not see Domin. She was traveling westbound on 12 Mile Road in a 1986 Mazda returning home from work.

No charges have been filed pending further investigation by police. No alcohol was in-

volved, police said.

Funeral services for Domin took place Dec. 19 at Griffin Funeral Home in Westland. He is survived by his fiancée, Deidra Lynn Dorman; parents Frank and Deborah Domin; sisters Denise Reddy and Amanda Domin; brother Timothy Domin and grandparents Donald and Joyce Domin, Audrey Jacobs and Erroll Bennett.

The Chuck Muer family has operated the popular eatery, formerly called Glamorgans, for the majority of its 25 years.

"We have worked hard to build a successful business," said Su-

san Muer, general manager. "Unfortunately, our sales have stagnated at a level that will not support our operating expense."

Muer, Chuck's daughter, said that all Magnum & Muer's employees are being transferred to either Muer restaurants in the area, like Big Fish, formerly Fairlane Charley's; Pul's, formerly Bloomfield Charley's; Rocky's, formerly Northville Charley's;

The Gandy Dancer in Ann Arbor; and Charley's Crab in Troy.

Those wishing to locate a favorite waiter or server can call the corporate office at 965-5555, Muer said.

She pegged location as a prime reason for shutting down.

"There's a lot of young families and senior citizens (in the area) who don't have a lot of disposable income," Muer said. "They don't

have \$23 for a tab. We just have not seen a growth in our business."

A Mountain Jack or Chi Chi's restaurant may fare better in the location which is for sale, Muer said.

Customers' "Frequent Dining Friends" accounts will be transferred to the Chuck Muer Restaurant of their choice, Muer said.
