Since April 27, four small businesses have been broken into, with several thousands of dollars worth of office equipment stoien. Police believe the thefa are related, but have no suspects. The latest incident was reported Wednesday morning at JM Associates on Freedom Road. People arrived to find the office of the surgiarized. Anywhore from \$3,000 to \$4,000 worth of office equipment was missing, including telephones and fax, adding and copy methines.

"We have not seen equipment of this nature taken before . . . things that are particular to businesses," said Farmington Public Safety Director Gary Goss. "This is something you would turn around and sell to another business."

Computer equipment, answering machines, fax machines and telephone equipment appear to be the main targets, though a television and a microwave oven were reported stolen in one helst.

More than \$3,000 in equipment was taken in a pair of burglaries at an adjoining office on Grand River. DBA Limited and Robert Diskow Advertising, both at 32880 Grand River, were hit sometime April 27 or 22.

Items worth nearly \$4,400 were taken at DBA Limited, including two Fackard Bell computers, along with a microwave oven and a television. A Macintoeth computer monitor, keyboard and color scanner were reported missing from Robert Diskow Advertising.

In a separate incident at Allistate Insurance, \$15 in cash was taken from a deak drawer. The burglary there occurred May 4 or 5.


