

Hills police sponsor run

The Farmington Hills Police Department will host a benefit 10-kilometer run — called the Cops for Kids Run — at 9 a.m. Saturday, June 5.

The run, which begins and ends at the Orchard Ridge campus of Oakland Community College, winds through several subdivisions. Proceeds from the event will be donated to the Muscular Dystrophy Association.

—New this year is a five-kilome-

ter run/walk and a one-mile fun run. Area businesses are partners with the police department in the effort to raise funds for MDA.

Brett Marquardt, a client of MDA, and his mother Terry Marquardt are expected to attend the race.
