Farmington hikes rates for water, sewer service

rarmington City Council members unanimously voted Monday to raise the rates of water and sewer services beginning July 1. This increase comes after the Oakland County Department of Public Services raised both their water and sewer rates and their aewago disposal rates.

In response to these bikes, Farmington will increase water rates by 11 cents for every 1,000 gallons sold. This brings the cost to \$1.50 per 1,000. Sewer rates for the year will in-crease in part because of the county raises. Also, the costs of local operation and maintenance

The rate will now be \$2.20 for every 1,000 gallons of water sold. This is up 38 cents from \$1.82.
