

School election day, absentee deadline approach

Farmington Public Schools will operate eight precincts for the election Monday, June 14. Polls are open 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Voters have until 2 p.m. Saturday to cast absentee ballots in person at the Lewis Schulman Center, 32500 Shiawassee St., Farmington. Mailed ballots will be accepted until 4 p.m. Monday.

There are nine candidates for two seats on the Farmington school board. They are Helen Ditzler, Bobbie Feldman, Terry Potts, Julia Glazer, Joel Maxwell, Susan McKendrick, Charles Remus, Kenneth Stein and David York.

Here's where to vote:

- Precinct 1 is at Longacre Elementary, 34850 Arundel, which includes the entire city of Farmington.
- Precinct 2 is at William Grace

- Precinct 8 is at Gill Elementary, 21195 Gill Road, which includes part of the district beginning at Haggerty Road east on Eight Mile Road to the Farmington city limits north to Nine Mile Road, west to Gill Road north to the Farmington city limits west to M-102, northwest to Halsted Road north to 10 Mile Road west to Haggerty Road south to Eight Mile Road.
