At times she can be direct in her approach to a task. She can discard non-essentials and move right into action.

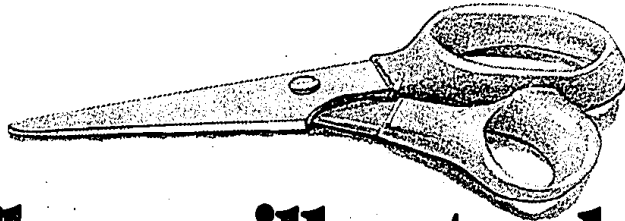
In the business world she might have difficulty sitting still for an extended period to concentrate on a mental project. She is best suited for a job that provides freedom of movement.

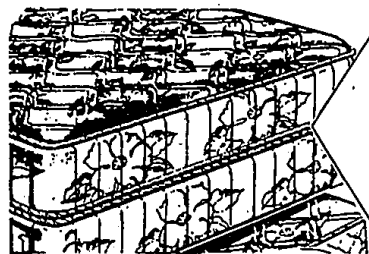
