Business joins in cleanup

A Farmington Hills company is living up to its name and helping the city prepare for its 20th anniversary celebration.

Mike's Cleaners and Tailors on Orchard Lake will take part along with the city and county in a cleanup of Orchard Lake Road, between 12 and 14 Mile Thursdays.

"We felt we should do something for our city for the 20th anniversary, especially since most of us live within the city," said Fred Amadi, manager of Mike's.

Rick Lampi, the city's community development coordinator, said city DPW workers and county road crews will make curb and

other repairs on Orchard Lake as part of the coordinated effort with 10 to 12 Mike's employees.

"The Year 2000 committee was looking for ways to beautify the city," he said. "This is a great way to do it and a good time with the city's 20th birthday celebration coming up."

Volunteers from Mike's will pick up litter, add wood chips and other materials to improve the landscaping and work with city and county crews in two groups, Amadi said. One group will work south of 13 Mile and one will work north of 13 Mile beginning

at about 8:30 a.m., he said. "Hopefully, it won't be too hot," he said. "We expect to work for about four hours."

Mayor Nancy Bates gave Councilman Ben Marks credit for working with businesses in the area on projects to improve the business climate, including the cleanup.

Bates said she hopes the cleanup effort is the beginning of other cooperative ventures between the private sector and the city to improve the city's business climate and appearance.
