After the first year of bloom, timely pruning is necessary. Early spring bloomers need to be pruned back in late winter to a height of about 24 to 36 inches after flowering.

Late-spring or early-summer flowering plants, which also produce flowers on new wood, need to be cut back to 24 inches the following spring. Denton's goal is May 1. Then, the late-blooming types, which are produced on the current year's growth, need to be pruned right to ground level at

Supporting roles

Denton has found that plants bought locally do better than the mail-ordered ones. She likes to buy them when they are about three feet high, in bud or already blooming.

She doesn't remove the support take that the plant is growing on

She doesn't remove the support take that the plant is growing on, but lets the vine continue to climb on the trellis, pole or other support provided. Wire mesh also gives good support. These tena-

cious plants can be easily pat-terned by tying them to a support until they are established.

There are more than 250 spe-cies and at least 5,000 cultivars in this family, so this wide selection should please the most discrimi-nating gardener. Our season be-gins in May and continues until the first frost. The feathery seeds that develop after bloom time add another facet to this favorite plant.


