



No matter what its reason for moving into the erea, there is little doubt that Bornes and Noble will have an impact upon the sales at Metro News when it opens in late August or early September. But Weiss said she doubts that the impact will be severe.

"I think that, initially, it's going to affect us, but when people see what we offer that Barnes and Noble can't, we don't have anything to worry about," Weiss said.
