Took Roundabout Trip to Escape Pursuers

One of the unnamed heroes of the South in the Civil war staged an unusual exploit that is still one of the most interesting traditions of Mobile bay. While the federal fleet lay off Port Morgan, this Southern sailor, out in a small sailboat, was chased by some of the enemy boats. Seeing them trying to intercept him he used all his sail power and nautical skill and headed eastward. For miles the chase continued and he left his pursuers behind. However, he knew they would be watching for him to return, so he kept on to the east, sailing to Appalachicola, Fla., where he landed his craft on a river steamer and made a trip of several days up the Chattahoochee to Columbus, Ga. There he transferred to a train for Opelika, then to Montgomery, Ala. At that point he changed cars for Hurricane, Ala., taking his boat along, and at Hurricane he launched his craft in the Tensaw river. He sailed down the river to Mobile bay and landed down the bay some 30 miles to Port Morgan.
