Mr. Bell of Michigan State College will have charge of this truck and it will stop at various places in the county.

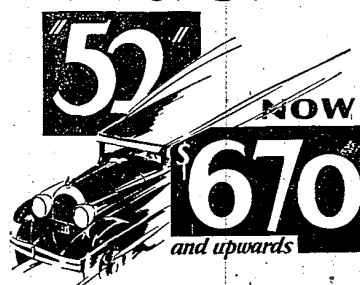
