This is an action to recover possession of lands held contrary to the conditions and covenants of an executory contract for the purchase thereof, said lands being described described as follows:

Property situated in the Township of Novi, and Farmington, Oakland County, Michigan, to-wit:
Parcel 1. The Southeast Quarter of Section 24, Town 1 North, Range 8 East, excepting therefrom lands conveyed by Erastus Ingersoll to his wife, to Clark Hazard, February 16, 1831, by deed recorded May 26, 1832 in Liber 5 of Deeds, page 311, Oakland County Register of Deeds Office, and also excepting lands conveyed by Theorem W. Barbour and wife, to Samuel Jones, Sr. and James H. Jones, May 24, 1859 by deed recorded December 6, 1859, in Liber 67 of Deeds, page 157, said Register's Office.

The above-mentioned parcels are described as follows:
A. Land in the Township of Farmington, County of Oakland and Territory of Michigan: Beginning in the Southwest corner of Southeast quarter of Section 24, in Town 1 North, Range 8 East in said Township and running East on the South line of said Section 24 to the center of the Detroit and Howell Plank Road; thence in a Northerly direction along the center of said Detroit and Howell Plank Road, far enough so that a line running in a Northerly direction parallel with the East line of said Section 24 to the North line of the said East half of the Southeast quarter of said Section 24 shall contain 22 acres of land.

The aforesaid parties of the first part meaning to convey to the said parties of the second part 22 acres of land on the East part of that portion of the East half of the Southeast quarter of said Section 24, which lies North of the Detroit and Howell Plank Road.

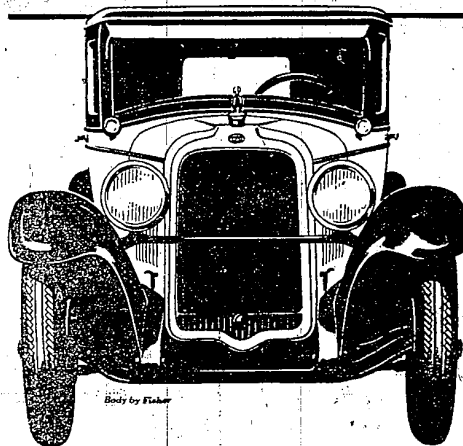

A Station-to-Station call is one that is made to a certain telephone, rather than to some person in particular.

If you do not know the number of the distant telephone, give the operator the name and address and specify that you will talk with "anyone" who answers at the called telephone.

Day rates, 4:30 a. m. to 7 p. m., and evening rates, 7 p. m. to 8:30 p. m., are higher than night rates.

A Person-to-Person call, because more work is involved, costs more than a Station-to-Station call. The rate on a Person-to-Person call is the same at all hours.
