Sweden and Finland claimed.

The League brought about an agreement satisfactory to both.

The first division of the League of Nations consists of the Assembly which meets at Geneva, Switzerland. Delegates are sent yearly and all nations have equal voting rights in the annual election of the president and in other major transactions.

The second division is the Council which meets four or more times yearly. Every organization must have an executive committee which can settle questions that the assembly cannot attend to.

The League of Nations' library contains books and magazines in all languages.

The Health Committee fights the epidemics and also does research work to find their causes.

The third division is the Economic Organization. Problems similar to the "Stabilization of the Austrian Krone" are settled.

In all the League of Nations is a piece of machinery which can or cannot be used for peace.

### THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS

"Ten or fifteen years from now the government of the world will rest on the shoulders of the generation who does not remember the war and so the ambition of the League of Nations is to remove the conditions that cause war," stated Miss Ursula Hubbard in her lecture last Thursday evening at the Salem Evangelical Church of Farmington.

All but seven countries of the world united for the purpose of promoting international peace and removing the conditions that cause war. The countries that did not join represent a population of less than 20% of that of the world.

The League is made up of the assembly, council and executive committee. The council meets four times a year and has been known to assembly with two days' notice.

It costs \$2,700,000,000 per year to keep up the United States armaments however, it only costs \$4,500,000 per year to keep all the nations of the world at peace through this League. In other words a yearly budget for the United States armaments would keep the machinery of the League in running order for 30 years.

Two outstanding things have been accomplished by the machinery of the League which has been working nine years, namely: better health and protection of health, especially in the foreign ports and removal of secret alliances which existed before the war. Before the war alliances were effective no matter what wrong the country had committed. Now, all countries combine against the wrongdoer.

Public opinion must have faith in the League of Nations and it cannot succeed without beneficial propaganda.

Slides of Europe connected with the League of Nations supplemented Miss Hubbard's lecture.
