PREVENTION OF HOLIDAY FIRES SIMPLE MATTER

How terrible it is to read newspaper accounts of fires at Christmas time! This is the happiest season of the year, especially for children, but fires bring suffering and death, creating a roaring furnace of flames where but a short time before had been a joyous home.

time before had been a joyous home.
Yet simple precautions will prevent holiday fires:
When using a candle in your window, be sure it is an electrib one, properly wired, as they are generally safe.
If you have a Christmas tree, set it up securely so it cannot thopple over. Don't place it neating or lighting fixtures.
For trimming the tree use noly noncombustible materials as metal tinsel, fake asbestos and powdered mica for snow effects.
For illuminating the tree, light-

dered mica for snow effects. For illuminating the tree, lighted candles should never be used. Properly installed electric lights are safer and give a colorful effect, but safest of all is a colored spotlight focussed on the tree. Again it is necessary to caution smokers to be careful with their matches and smoking materials near trees and decorations. Ocurse, keep matches out of the reach of small children.—Exchange.
