How do I convince the board of the need to update our documents?

bers of the board that the cooperative could, indeed, spend many dollars on legal foes in attempting to retrieve the shares of a defaulting cooperative member through unnecessary court proceeddings, which are required, simply because of the inndequacy of the coopertive documents.

If the board recognizes this liabili-ty, it will recognize, hopefully, its business responsibility to raise enough money in order to engage competent counsel to come up with an updated set of cooperative bylaws and a revised proprietary lease.
