SWIM LESSONS

The course will meet Oct. 18, 20, and 22 from 6 to 9 p.m. and Oct. 23 from 9 a.m. to noon. Participants must attend all sessions and pass a written test to qualify for the certificate and be 12 years of age by March 1994. Preregistration fee of \$5 per person is required.
