MAX E. KIELING

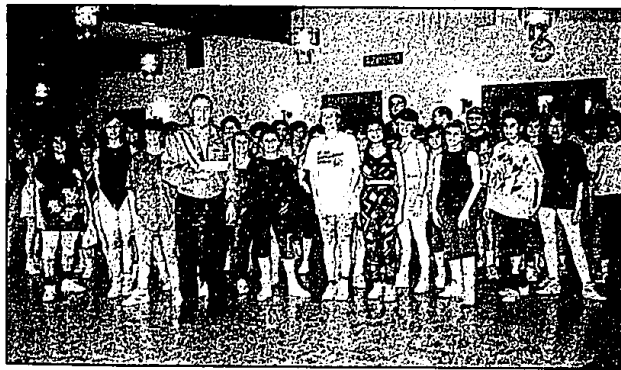
Mr. Kieling, 66, of Manistee, formerly of Farmington, died Nov. 29 at Botsford Hospital, Farmington Hills.
