

Estimates for the cost of a twosurface, multi-use fee arean were
originally in the \$6.7 million to \$8
million range, based on cost estimates from two architectural
firms.

Committee members agreed
that many items could be
trimmed and city manager Bill

eporting goods, said he found those estimates high. Bob Washer a committee member whose Southfield building company has experience with ice arenas, said labor and other costs vary depending on the region and that an arena designed for California or Indiana might not be practical for Farmington Hills. Costick told the committee that the city's bond rating and other factors would allow it to pay for

an arena with either general obligation bends or revenue bends that could be paid off with profits from the arena.

Hills Mayor pro tem Larry Lichtman, who chairs the committee, said he was comfortable with the range of cost estimates. He added that although two private developers have expressed interest in an arena, he last concerned that the city would be stepping on toes by building and running an arena.

"Wo'rs not competing with the private sector," he said. "No one less is doing this."

Although there were a lot of unresolved issues, the timing could not be better for building an arena, Lichtman said.


