22 Take OEO Data Training

The Oakland County Commission on Economic Opportunity has just released a report on its summer training-employment program in data processing held in conjunction with General Motors and Oakland University.

Trainees were 22 hard-core unemployed who took a seven-week orientation course in data processing at Oakland University. OU picked up the tab of \$770 for the program, which was offered free of charge to those who enrolled.

Purpose of the program was to acquaint the unemployed with work-a-day attitudes, employer-employee relationships, proper grooming, legal aid, interview methods and how to apply for and get a job.

At the conclusion of the program, five of the trainees went to work in computers at GM plants and the rest took other jobs on the basis of their performance in the course.
