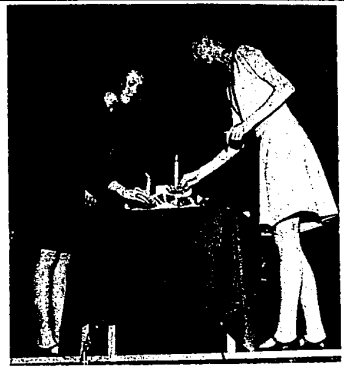


### Bank Study Unit Picks Advisors

State Sen. George W. Kuhn (R-West Bloomfield) today announced the formation of an Advisory Bank Study Committee to assist the Joint Senate-House Bank Study Committee as it considers possible major bank structure changes in Michigan.

Kuhn said, "The formation of this group of bankers now completes the organizational structure of the legislative study committee." Earlier, in August, the committee selected the firm of Carter H. Colombe Associates, an out-state firm, as the main consultant to the committee.

The major bank changes currently under consideration include: Shall corporations be allowed to own bank stock? Shall Michigan law permit the formation of bank holding companies? Shall the Michigan branch banking law be changed to permit an extension beyond the current 25-mile limitation?

### County Budget At \$141 Million

A recommended Wayne County budget of \$141 million is before the County Board of Supervisors for consideration.

The budget, as recommended by the County Board of Auditors, is the highest on record -- \$14 million above the current year's appropriations of \$127 million.

"In general, the level of service programs budgeted for 1968-1969 has been slightly improved and expanded to meet the needs of the community more adequately," the Board of Auditors stated in its budget message.

The budget increase reflects anticipated higher revenues, the auditors stated. The county tax rate remains at the current \$7.07 per \$1,000 of equalized valuation.

THE BUDGET anticipates a \$3,822,000 increase in property tax revenues, reflecting new construction and rising land values in the county; a \$2,655,000 in the county's share of state income tax revenue; and a \$10,844,000 increase in revenues from grants and service charges and fees for county services.

The additional revenue will be used to finance nearly \$3.5 million in pay increases provided in union contracts negotiated earlier this year.
