Croolese is the grammatical interpretation of English.

Programming from Guyana was videotaped by Philip Singer. There are three programs. It is important for a television viewer, however, to watch each show from the beginning. Because these documentaries are from an anthropological perspective you will need to see them from the beginning and watch the entire program to understand the emphasis.

"Trance, Dance, and Healing in Guyana" is the first of the series. This program was selected to be shown in the Margaret Mead Film Festival For New York.

"Kali Mai — Devine Madness" is the second of the series and will be submitted to the Margaret Mead Film Festival These programs are case histories of the village psychotherapy. Described are problems of attention deficit disorder, school anxiety, sexual dysfunctions and psychosomatic problems. Handled by the village

therapist, they are brief and resolved without the use of drugs.
"How the Mental Hospital
Flunctions in Guyana" is the third
of the series. This program shows
the hospital in contrast with the
village therapist's approach.
This "visually demanding"




